INDUSTRY OVERVIEW

The plastics and plastic products industry is a dynamic and vibrant growth sector within the Malaysian manufacturing sector. Over the years, the plastics industry has been supporting the growth of related sectors as well as contributing to the emergence of new markets throughout the value chain. Between 2013 and 2018, the plastics industry saw a total approved investments of RM2.91 billion in 163 projects. These investments have created 12,500 job opportunities. With more than 1,500 companies in operation today, Malaysia is among the ASEAN region's top exporter of plastics. In 2016, export of plastic products saw an increase of 1.24% to RM13.06 billion from RM13 billion in 2015. The growth momentum continued at RM3.5 billion in the first quarter of 2017. The primary export destinations include Europe. China, Singapore, Japan and Thailand.


